SEM curriculum

The new curriculum has been approved subject to actions. We have submitted a response to these actions and await the final approval. Thank you to everyone who has been involved in this process.

Transition to the new curriculum

The current GMC recommendation is that all trainees that have more than one year of clinical training from August 2021 will need to transition to the new curriculum. If there is planned Out of Programme (OOP) experience, maternity leave or sickness absence then this does not extend to this.

CESR update

We ran a successful virtual TEAMs CESR training day for new assessors on 10th July 2020; in total there were 5 new assessors being trained and 2 returning recently trained assessors. Thank you to all those who attended and have stepped up and offered their time to undertake assessments in the future. We are still receiving regular applications. As a reminder, the new curriculum for CESRs will only be used from its implementation for specialty training in August 2021.

The RCP are continuously canvassing the GMC to pay assessors for their time but it still remains a voluntary role.
