

Current Diploma Ceremony/Faculty Membership

Currently when someone sits and passes both parts of the FSEM Membership exam they are sent a letter from the President (Appendix 1) which congratulates them and advises them of their post nominals. They are also sent a Diploma (Appendix 2) and an Application Form (Appendix 3) to become a member of the Faculty.

It is at the Diploma Ceremony in September, that if they have decided to become a member of the Faculty they are presented with their Certificate of Membership.

With the first sitting of the MSK Diploma due to be sat on 8 June, is it the intention of the Faculty for the process of Diploma and Membership to mirror that of the Faculty Exam and Membership?

OR

Should we change the process to:

When an exam is sat and passed (regardless of Faculty or MSK) they are sent a letter of congratulations and invited to attend the Diploma Ceremony to collect their Diploma for passing their exam. If they have completed the application to become a member or diplomate, they are also presented with their membership certificate.

I think that it is important to keep both Faculty Membership and MSK Diplomate Membership in the same format.
