New curriculum:

There will be a launch of the new curriculum on June 9th, 2021 at 1pm. There is no need to register, just join on the day.

The Rough Guide to support the implementation of the new curriculum has been completed.

The Specialty Specific Guidance for CESR applicants for the new curriculum has been written and is with the GMC for approval and will be uploaded onto the website once available

CESR assessor training

A further 2 CESR assessors were trained on 19th May 2021. Thank you to both the assessors for putting themselves forward and to Eleanor Tillet and John Rogers for delivering the training. Hopefully this new format will enable us to train more new assessors.

CESR applications:

These continue to come in and we continue to struggle with senior assessors in particular but hopefully as the new assessors become more experienced things will improve.

Training Recovery:

ARCPs for all trainees will be happening over the next 2 months. We will then have a better feel for the impact of Covid on training. This is likely to impact for the next 2-3 years. The SAC has devised a revised decision aid with appropriate derogations to allow progression at ARCP without affecting quality of training and the standard of trainee gaining a CCT, which has been approved by the GMC.
