- Must have obtained Certificate of Completion of Training (CCT) and be on the Specialist Register.
- Experience in the rehabilitation of musculoskeletal injuries is essential and post-holder must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills and be fully Information Technology (IT) literate, including use of Microsoft Office, electronic patient records, videoconferencing, and radiology software etc.

Desirable Criteria:

- Experience of working with young adults.
- Experience of working with chronic pain or illness, application of the biopsychosocial model and fully integrated interdisciplinary team working.
- Experience of practicing medicine in an occupational context.

Please note the salary will be pro-rata where part time hours are undertaken.

There is no requirement to deploy as this is met by our uniformed personnel, but you will form the continuity of care required by our patients when based at home.
