FOR INFORMATION

For the current year, we are expecting to conduct approximately 80 appraisals of which 62 come under the Faculty for revalidation. This is a few less than my report to the Executive last week and is a small decrease as some doctors have retired or will be retiring this year. The administration staff are endeavouring to ensure that all appraisees are engaging in the process and co-ordinating appraisals meetings following the postponements due to the pandemic. There are a few doctors that have needed to be deferred and pushed to complete their necessary GMC Good Medical Practice guidelines.

A total of 10 doctors have been revalidated in the period (October-December 2021) with 7 due for the period (January-March 2022). There has been an influx due to Covid and the GMC preferring revalidations to be deferred by one year.

We are planning to host a training session organised by MIAD Healthcare with dates to be confirmed hopefully in person but with online available.

One of our Appraisers has stepped down with another still on sabbatical and we will be looking to recruit another.

A review of the Faculty's Appraisal and Revalidation processes is being considered by an external provider.
