Role Description

An exciting opportunity has become available as we look to recruit the first Chair of the new Musculoskeletal (MSK) Committee for the Faculty of Sport and Exercise Medicine UK.

The Role

The Chair of the MSK Medicine Committee should be a Member or Fellow of the Faculty, with experience in primary and secondary care; with current or recent extensive experience on delivering MSK services in the NHS. The Chair must have previous leadership experience and be able to operate confidentially in leading the committee to implement the Faculty's strategy. As the professional membership organisation for Sport and Exercise Medicine within the UK, a key objective is to increase our influence within the NHS across the four nations. This involves working with national partners to develop collaborative models for both musculoskeletal care and physical activity for integrated care systems. We are looking to appoint the Chair who has multi-professional and interdisciplinary leadership experience.

The Chair will work with the Faculty to appoint the first members to the MSK Medicine Committee and set the committee's terms of reference.

Commitment:

- The Chair will be co-opted onto Council and will therefore attend quarterly Council meetings (3 meetings online usually 1-4pm online, with one in-person meeting in London, Birmingham, or Edinburgh).
- Quarterly Committee reports are due to Council on the progress, actions, or requests from the committee.
- The Chair will also meet with the Office Bearers group every 8 weeks during a 30-minute lunchtime update meeting
- Stakeholders' engagement meetings as and when required.
