Role Description

An exciting opportunity has become available as we are looking to recruit a Sport and Exercise Medicine Resident to represent SEM Residents on the SAC Committee.

About the Role

This role would be ideally suited to a Resident in the latter stages of their training – ST5 and above but this can be reviewed and discussed on an individual basis.

Examples of duties

- Provide a link between SAC and SEM Residents representatives
- Provide reports to the lead FSEM SEM Resident Representatives
- Support the organisation of the National Training days

The role is shared with another SAC Resident representative, therefore you will be expected to coordinate roles and responsibilities with your co-representative.

Length of Role and Commitment

The SAC Representative role will commence on **1st August**, for a period of **two years**.

Attendance is expected at all three meetings per year, shared with your co-representative. They are typically held at the Royal College of Physicians, London in October, March and June, but dates may vary.

Eligibility Criteria

- The representative must be undertaking Higher Specialty Training in the UK
- Applicants must hold membership with FSEM (Associate, Diplomate, Member are applicable), for an understanding of FSEM's objectives and ongoing projects.
- The representative must be committed to serve for a duration of two years.
- The representative should be ST4 or ST5, but ST3 Residents who are within three months of ST4 may be considered.
- Applications must be supported by the Resident doctor's Training Programme Director.
- Applications must be proposed and seconded by a Member or Fellow of FSEM.
