

Job Description

Faculty Appraiser

The Faculty of Sport and Exercise Medicine UK (FSEM) provides an appraisal and revalidation service for its Fellows and Members which is compliant with the requirements of the [GMC's Good medical practice framework](#) for appraisal and revalidation of doctors practicing in the UK.

We are looking to recruit to our team of Appraisers. Appraisers must be a Fellow of the Faculty and have at least five years' experience in SEM.

Successful applicants will undergo specialist training in appraisal provision which is provided by the Faculty. This takes roughly half a day and is done remotely.

About the Role

Appraisers are expected to conduct around six appraisals per year. The Faculty appraisals are all completed using the Agilio Clarity Appraisal Toolkit for continuity. All appraisals have an approval review by a senior appraiser, and our Suitable Person Dr Dave Pugh, and our Exams and Standards Manager Claire MacPherson will be available for any queries or issues while appraising.

The current fee for conducting each appraisal is £350.00 which involves preparatory work, the appraisal meeting and completion of the appraisal documentation.

All appraisers must be able to operate confidentially, with diplomacy, empathy and discretion and be able to demonstrate advanced interpersonal and communication skills.

Meetings and Training

Appraisers will join the Appraisal and Revalidation Committee and are expected to meet online at least three times per year. The committee is a forum for appraisers

and staff to inform and update on relevant topics associated with appraisal and revalidation. It aims to develop the appraisal service and provides an opportunity for peer-to-peer support. Appraisers may be asked to assist the chair in the development of aspects of the service. In addition, the appraiser is expected to attend mandatory annual training.
